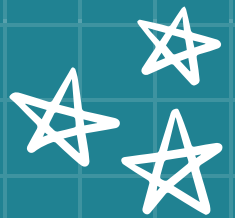
# Implementation Roadmap

## Per Student Sponsorship

NGOs pay per child enrolled (very affordable rate).

Flat rate for multiple students in community centers.

NGOs can fundraise for specific child groups to access AHS.
